



Understanding Learning Difficulties – eLearning Course Frequently Asked Questions

Q. When will this course be available?

A. The Understanding Learning Difficulties e-learning course is available now.

Q. How do I sign-up?

A. You will be able to register for this e-learning course by visiting DSF's online store located at www.store.dsf.net.au. A link to access our new online learning platform is also available on our homepage.

Q. How much does it cost?

A. The cost of the course varies depending on whether you are a current member of DSF. Currently the cost of accessing the course is as follows:

Q. Is there a discount for schools who would like to enrol more than one teacher or staff member?

Member Discounts of 5% also apply to member schools.

Q. Is there a discount for students or early career teachers and professionals?

A. Yes. DSF does offer a discount for current full-time students who are studying either Education, Psychology or Speech Pathology. In addition, DSF has made provisions to support early career teachers, psychologists and speech pathologists who are in their first year of post graduate employment. Proof of enrolment and employment status will be requested.

Q. How many hours will it take to complete?

A. This e-Learning course consists of six, 2-hour modules. It is expected that it will take approximately 12 hours to complete this e-learning course.

Q. Is there a time limit on how long I can access the course?

A. Once enrolled, participants will have access to the course for 12 months.

Q. Are there any assignments or assessment tasks?

A. This e-Learning course has been designed to be an interactive learning experience with many opportunities to test your knowledge and understanding through a series of quizzes. All information needed to successfully pass the end of module quizzes is contained within the course itself and participants have an unlimited number of attempts to complete the quizzes. There are no assignments set for this course however, there is a final assessment task (extended quiz) that needs to be passed in order to complete the course.

Q. Do I get a certificate when I have completed the course?

A. Yes. Once the final assessment task has been completed and feedback submitted, a certificate of completion can be downloaded immediately.

Q. Who should complete the course?

A. This e-Learning course has been designed to equip teachers, school psychologists, speech pathologists, specialist tutors and education support staff with the knowledge required to support students with learning difficulties throughout their education.

Q. Does this course count towards any continuing professional development for teachers, psychologists or speech pathologist?
